

MPP Assessment of Recognition for Prior Learning (RPL) applications

Who will review RPL and make decisions about each Unit?

- The MPP Course Coordinator will review RPL applications
- Where necessary, the Course Coordinator will confer with MPP Unit Coordinators and the Placement Coordinator.

In reaching a decision, what does Course Coordinator consider?

- Nature and amount of evidence provided by the applicant
- Scope of the subject matter covered by the application
- Specific needs of the applicant (language, special needs, etc)
- Number of equivalent student contact hours, EFTLS or credit points involved in formal learning
- Type and comparability of assessment/s and learning outcomes for formal and informal study
- Whether the unit / experience was conducted in a similar course
- Whether all learning outcomes have been met
- Other considerations addressed in the CMI Policy for [Advanced Standing and Recognition-of-Prior-Learning](#).

What can RPL and course credit be granted for?

- One or more whole Units of study or modules within the course
- No more than 50% of the credit points in any one program or course
- Only coursework from an accredited and equivalent APAC course.

What can RPL and course credit NOT be granted for?

- Previous placement experience.
