2020 September Intake: Master of Clinical Psychology (Post Registration)

Unit offerings:

Most subjects (units) are offered in multiple specific teaching periods. Students need to plan their course sequence accordingly. You only need to successfully complete each unit once.

Standard considerations:

You must undertake and complete at least one placement (CLP661) before you undertake the Research Project (CLP650).

We do not normally recommend dual enrolment in two or more placements in the same semester (special approval would be needed prior to the relevant census if this is your plan).

Note: additional offerings may become available if a mid-year intake or special interstate intakes are offered at a later stage.

Recommended Part-time Plan:

September 2020 intake:	CLP601 and CLP602
2021 Semester 1:	Placement 1 (CLP661)
2021 Semester 2:	CLP603 and CLP604
2021 Summer school:	Placement 2 (CLP662)
2022 Semester 1:	Research Project (CLP650) <u>or</u> Placement 3 (CLP663)
2022 Semester 2:	Placement 3 (CLP663) <u>or</u> Research Project (CLP650)

Recommended Fast-track Plan (instead of Full-time):

Because the September intake semester is only offered as a part-time option, this is technically an accelerated part-time plan with only 2021 Semester 2 technically being a full-time study load.

September 2020 intake:	CLP601 and CLP602
2021 Semester 1:	Placement 1 (CLP661)
2021 Semester 2:	CLP603 and CLP604 and Placement 2 (CLP662)
2021 Summer school:	Placement 3 (CLP663) and Research Project (CLP650)

Because the first full-time intake is February 2021 this plan will have the same completion dates as the 2021 Full-time intake.

You could optionally undertake the Research Project (CLP650) in 2021 Semester 2 instead of Summer School, making Semester 2 your only standard full-time semester, however the more distributed pathway is just our standard recommendation.

Standard 2021 Full-Time Plan:

This is the standard full-time plan that will be recommended for the February 2021 intake. It is presented here for comparison.

Semester 1:	CLP601 and CLP602 , and Placement 1 (CLP661)
Semester 2:	CLP603 and CLP604 , and Placement 2 (CLP662)
Summer school:	Placement 3 (CLP663)
